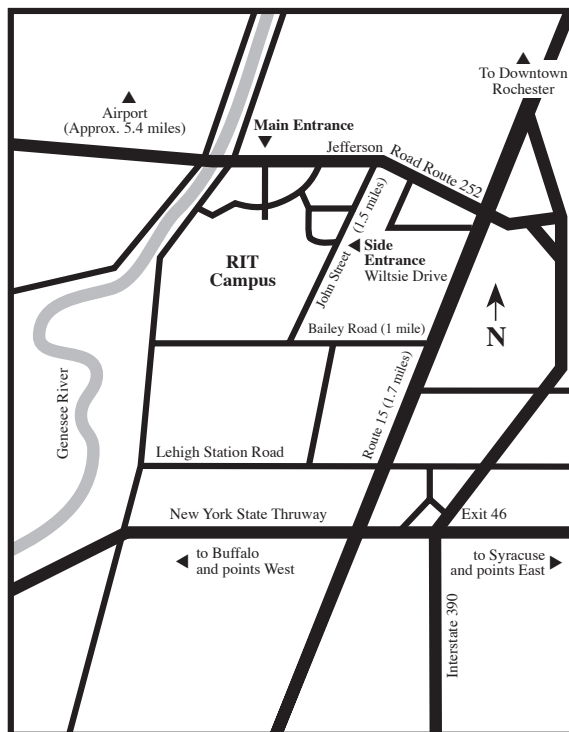

## Directions to RIT

From New York State Thruway, take exit 46 to Interstate 390. Proceed north on 390 to Hylan Drive. Turn left on Jefferson. Road and travel two miles to the main campus entrance on the left.



## Directions to RIT Inn and Conference Center

From New York State Thruway (Route 90):  
Exit the Thruway (coming east or west) at Rochester exit 46. Take LeHigh Station Road exit to end of ramp. Turn left and proceed approximately one-half mile to West Henrietta Road (Route 15). Turn left and proceed south on West Henrietta Road to hotel entrance approximately one-half mile on right.

## Directions to RIT from Hotel

Turn left out of hotel. Proceed north on West Henrietta Road to Bailey Road. Turn left on Bailey. Proceed west about one mile. Turn right on John Street. Proceed north about three-quarters of a mile. Turn left onto campus. Follow road to Athletic Center. (Parking Lot D)

## Tournament Director Bob McVean



Since coming to RIT in 1983, Bob McVean has produced six All-Americans and 49 All-Conference players. Craig Jones, RIT's career scoring leader, was named NCAA Player of the Year in 1996.

In 1995 McVean became the winningest coach in RIT history and has since surpassed 400 victories. In 1997 RIT was 24-4 and competed in the NCAA Division III playoffs for the third straight time. The Tigers responded by advancing to the Sweet 16 round. The 24 wins marked the most ever by an RIT team since the program began in 1915. In 2003 RIT was NY Upstate ECAC Champions. The Tigers have been to post season tournaments 16 consecutive years. McVean has been named Empire Eight Conference Coach of the Year seven times.

Prior to RIT, McVean guided Eisenhower College. In 1979-80, he was named NAIA District Coach of the Year and took the Generals to the playoffs.
