Wayne Wilson - The RIT Head Hockey Coach is now entering his 10th season with the RIT Tigers Division I Hockey Team. Coached RIT to an Atlantic Hockey Association league title the first year in the league in 2006-07 and a second place finish in 2007-08. Prior to RIT, worked as an assistant at Bowling Green for 12 years. Played 4 years on defense for Bowling Green and captained team to NCAA Championship in 1984.

Brian Hills - The Associate Head Coach with the Tigers just finished his third year at RIT. Prior to RIT, was head coach at SUNY Geneseo for 4 years and was an assistant with Bowling Green for 7 years. Played 11 years professionally in Europe after graduating from Bowling Green in 1983. Led CCHA in scoring in 1982 and 1983, was a two-time All-American and two-time Hobey Baker candidate.

Mike Gernain - Has been an assistant coach on the RIT staff for the past 2 seasons. Mike works extensively with the Tiger goaltenders who have been amongst the top in the league the past 2 years. Worked 1 season with the Rochester Americans of the American League as a video coordinator. For 5 seasons, Mike was the Associate Head Coach of the Rochester Americans Jr. B team. Was an outstanding collegiate goaltender for the Cortland Dragons from 1992-1996.

Scott McDonald - Is currently in his second season as Head Women's Hockey Coach at RIT. Led the women's program to an ECAC Northeast regular season title in 2006-07 and a second place finish in the ECAC West Division in 2007-08. Prior to that, worked as an assistant with the RIT men's team for 3 years and Utica College for 2 years. Played professionally with San Angelo in the WPHL and 1 year in Sweden. Had an outstanding 4 year career on defense with Niagara University where he helped lead them to an NCAA Tournament bid in 2000.
